



Lion Dance Terminology

1. 高举 (Gaoju – High raise)
2. 高举 **180** (Gaoju 180 – High raise with 180 degree turn)
3. 高举 **360** (Gaoju 360 – High raise with 360 degree turn)
4. 上腿 (Shangtui – Stand on the legs)
5. 高举上腿转身 **360** (Gaoju Shangtui Zhuanshen 360 – High raise + stand on the legs + 360 degree turn)
6. 坐肩 (Zuojian – Sit on the shoulders)
7. 坐肩转 (Zuojian Zhuan – Sit on the shoulders and turn)
8. 夹腰旋转 (Jiaoyao Xuanzhuan – Hang on the waist and turn)
9. 啃舔挠 (Ken Tiaonao – Nibbling, licking and scratching)
10. 甩尾 (Shuaiwei – Flicking the tail)
11. 滚翻 (Gunfan – Rolling and tumbling)
12. 滚背 (Gunbei – Rolling over the back)
13. 探球 (Tanqiu – Seeking and playing with the ball)
14. 爬像 (Paxiang – Imitating crawling)
15. 怕像 (Paxiang – Imitating fear)
16. 坐头 (Zuotou – Sitting on the head)
17. 亮相 (Liangxiang – Picture-perfect pose)
18. 引狮员 (Yingshi Yuan – The lion leader)
19. 绣球 (Xiuqiu – The embroidered ball)
20. 狮形 (Shixing – The shape and form of the lion)
